

# Privacy Policy Eternity Group

Eternity Group, reg. no 559223-6698, ("Eternity Group", "we") is the data controller and responsible for the processing of personal data, in accordance with the General Data Protection Regulation (also known as GDPR). This policy is applicable from 25 May 2018 when the GDPR enters into force.

## **The data controller**

We do not sell or rent your personal information. We may share your data with trusted third parties only when necessary to provide our services or as required by law.

## Data Retention

Eternity Group will keep your personal data for a maximum period required for the purpose it was collected for or if it is necessary in order to fulfil any other purpose that does not contradict the purpose for which it was first collected. The retention period varies depending on the contractual obligation and any potential related legal obligation. Normally, the data is erased two years after the agreement has been terminated.

## Data Security

We implement appropriate technical and organizational measures to protect your data from unauthorized access, alteration, or disclosure. Only those who need access to your personal data for the fulfilment of Eternity Group's purposes stated above will be given access to your data.

## Your Rights

- Object to or restrict the processing of your data
